4. A grade of "C" or higher is required for a course to transfer.
5. Students declare pre-social work as their major upon transfer to WCU and must maintain an overall minimum GPA of 2.8 before being considered for admission to the BSW program.
6. Transfer students are advised to apply to the program immediately while taking SOCW 251 in their first semester.
7. A total of 120 semester hours is required for the BSW degree. (42 hours of liberal studies, 67 hours in the Social Work major and 11 hours of general electives.
8. It is recommended that students meet their ULP requirement with a P3, P5, or P6 class
