SILVER EXPECTATIONS	
Create a welcoming environment by introducing yourself, explaining your role at the college, and encouraging the student to share his/her background and goals.	Appreciative Advising: Disarm
Ask the student if they have a job/children/other outside responsibilities. Do they have any challenges managing it all?	Appreciative Advising: Discover
Confirm student's career goal and that it aligns with the academic program s/he is currently enrolled at SCC.	PEAK & Career Center AVISO
Verify that a student's major is listed correctly in Datatel/Colleague. If not, help student complete a Change of Major form during the advising session.	Datatel Mnemonics Forms Advising Webpage
Verify the student's contact information (address, phone number) is correct. If not, help student complete a Change of Address form during the advising session.	DATATEL Mnemonics Forms
Verify that all transcripts are in st-IASU. Inform student if transcripts are missing.	Datatel Mnemonics
Review student course progress in STAC, TRCL or AVISO.	Student's Datatel Account AVISO
