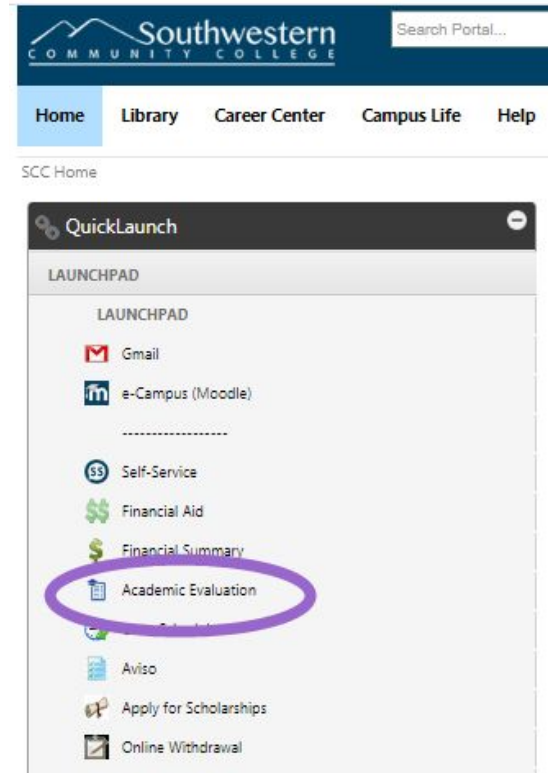

Section 1: Courses in Parts A thru E of this section are UGETCs (Universal General Education Transfer Components).

Part A: This student has **Completed** both ENG 111 & 112.

Part B: 3 Humanities/Fine Arts courses are required. This student needs 2 more classes as this section is **In Progress**.

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Part F allows students to choose additional General Education courses that do not have to be UGETCs.

Group 1 - Student could consider selecting a Humanities course from the Group 1 list in the blue section above since the requirement is **Not Started**.

Group 2 - The SOC 213 **Completes** this additional requirement Social Science that doesn't have to be a UGETC.

Group 3 - The additional science requirement is **Complete**.

Group 4 - Student could consider a Mathematics course from the Group 4 list in the blue section above since the requirement is **Not Started**.

Section 2 includes free elective choices.

Wise students consult Baccalaureate Degree Plans (BPD) for majors of interest at future universities and select courses that will contribute toward those degrees. For example, students interested in Business are likely to need Accounting courses (ACC 120, 121) and Business Law (BUS 115). *Consulting with an advisor is recommended.*

Section 2

Part A: Not Started. Student should definitely complete ACA 122 in the next term. This course helps students prepare to transfer to a university. Transfer students should enroll in ACA 122 in their 1st or 2nd semester preferably.

Part B: This is where a student should choose 14 hours of coursework that will contribute toward a planned future university major. Generally, students should **not** complete all the elective requirements before courses in **Section 1** are completed. Note the terms for this transcript. This student was previously enrolled in a healthcare program, which explains why all the elective credits are Science related and the elective requirements are **Complete**.
