The foundation is a small department of 2 on our campus. The deadline is April 26th. After the deadline, the committee reads the applications (which was 268 applications last year). There is a meeting then with Tyler Cook to ensure that all of the applicants meet the criteria for the scholarships. Awards are given in the Fall and Spring divided evenly. Money is not given until a handwritten thank you note is turned into the foundation. There are 55 scholarships with 32 endowed with \$165,000 to be given out this year. This has increased in the last 7 years from \$30,000! To apply, students complete one application. That application is then matched with the correct scholarship. There are several scholarship workshops coming up to let students work with our wonderful financial aide and foundation departments. These workshops are on April 2nd, April 10th and April 25th.
