The Veterans Administration provides veterans and reservists who meet the appropriate federal criteria a financial assistance program for education and training. Curriculum programs are approved by the State Approving Agency.

Applications for veterans' educational benefits must be made through the College's Financial Aid Office at least one month prior to enrollment in classes. Applicants must submit a copy of Form DD214 (discharge paper), if applicable, an official high school/GED transcript, and official transcripts from previous colleges or military programs. A veteran's transcript(s) must be on file and evaluated before he/she can be certified for veteran's benefits.

When a veteran enrolls, the student must pursue the exact curriculum listed and approved and must maintain satisfactory academic progress, attendance, and conduct for continuing eligibility for payments.
