## STUDENT SERVICES CURRICULUM COURSE PREREQUISITE AND COURSES UNIQUE TO CONCENTRATION

Policy 6.02.10

## I. CURRICULUM COURSE PREREQUISTE

The primary purpose of a prerequisite and/or co-requisite is to enhance student success. While the traditional manner by which students demonstrate their readiness is through the completion of courses, in exceptional cases, students may acquire requisite skill or knowledge through other means. In these cases, a prerequisite or co-requisite may be waived with the appropriate approvals. Only the Dean may waive a course prerequisite or co-requisite. The approval of the waiver and supporting documentation will be maintained on file.

## II. COURSES UNIQUE TO A CURRICULUM

A concentration shall include a minimum of 12 semester hours and the majority of the course credit hours shall be unique to the concentration.

If the College is approved for a concentration program, the College may register students from other programs in courses that are listed as unique to the approved concentration unless prohibited by state or local restrictions. Documentation of this process will occur following the normal advising and registration processes.
