Therapeutic Massage - Admission Criteria

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

- 1. Complete an application (if not currently enrolled). Designate Therapeutic Massage (either AAS, A45750 or Diploma, D45750) as the program of interest. If you are a current student, see Admissions to complete a change of major form if you wish to apply to the program.
- 2. Be a high school graduate or have earned a high school equivalency diploma (GED). Exception: current high school students.
- 3. Submit official copies of all transcripts (high school & college). Transcripts must be sent directly from the institution. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that all necessary records are sent to the College Admissions Office.
- 4. Students must meet with the program coordinator prior to completing a mandatory orientation session and must have SCC health forms completed by the appropriate medical personnel indictating the candidate is mentally and physically capable of performing the job duties required by the profession.

NOTES:

- Students are required to obtain a grade of "C" or better in all health science program and general education courses.
- The North Carolina Board of Massage and Bodywork will require a criminal background check upon application for licensure.
