We will be celebrating 25 years of Upward Bound at SCC and 60 years of TRIO programs with current students, families, alumni and staff.


Our College Tour Trip (for eligible students) is July 15-18 and will be to Kentucky with college visits, cultural experiences, and lots of fun!
